

The venue


Hotel Barceló Sants, in the centre of Barcelona, is very well connected.

It is very easy to arrive from the airport and from the AVE (fast trains to Madrid-Paris-Valencia).

Hotel Barceló Sants has an avant-garde and futuristic look that resembles a space station, where guests can imagine they're on an inter-galactic trip.

Located above Sants Railway Station and with direct access to the high-speed AVE and Barcelona's metro and local train links, this is the best-connected hotel in the city. It's just 500 metres from Plaza Espanya and the scenic Montjuïc district, 15 minutes by train from Barcelona El Prat Airport and 4 minutes by train from Plaza Catalunya.



Public transport & taxi

Hotel Barceló Sants is located over the Barcelona-Sants train and metro station. Serviced by RENFE, Metro, AVE.


Barcelona-El Prat airport is 12 km away. There is a direct connection via train from the airport (T2) and a bus.

Alternatively, a taxi from the airport will cost around 30-35€.

Finding the Hotel

If you are coming from inside Barcelona-Sants train station follow the signs to **Plaça de Joan Peiró**. Exit the Barcelona-Sants train station. The entrance to the Hotel is 50m on the right.

MoodleMoot Global 2023 course on Moodle Academy

The <u>MoodleMoot Global 2023 course</u> on Moodle Academy is your community space to connect with other attendees before and during the event, as well as give you access to further information and resources.

All MoodleMoot Global 2023 attendees have been enrolled in the course. If you haven't previously had a user account on Moodle Academy, check your email for your login details.

Registration

Registration for MoodleMoot Global 2023 attendees will take place on Tuesday 19 September from 8:15-9:00 am at the registration desk on the first floor.

Upon arrival at the venue, proceed up the stairs or take the elevator to the first floor. All registered attendees will receive their name badges. For safety reasons, badges must be worn at all times during the event. Name badges will include a QR code which other attendees can scan that will take them to the external link (i.e. LinkedIn) that attendees have included upon registering for the event. Attendees who did not provide a link to their profile during their registration, will not have a QR code on their name badge.

For those of you coming along to our Music Jam night (Tuesday) and Moodle Party (Wednesday), you will also receive a bracelet for each event. These bracelets will be your entry ticket, so be sure to keep them safe and wear them on the night.

Please be mindful of your belongings throughout the event and keep them secure. A cloakroom will be available for attendees during the event.






Jam Day

Installation

Installing the MoodleMoot Global app on your iOS or Android device will ensure that all of the information you need during the Moot is at your fingertips, and you'll be kept up to date with important alerts and notifications while you're in Barcelona.

The app will also allow you to view the event program and build a personalised schedule of sessions to attend. Make sure you are logged in with your moodlemoot.org details once you open the app to personalise your schedule.


iPhone installation

 Launch **Safari** mobile browser on your iPhone and go to https://moodlemoot.org/




- 2. Press the **share** icon.

When you first launch the app, you'll be prompted to enable notifications. Press **Allow.**






Android installation

- Launch your mobile browser on your Android and go to https://moodlemoot.org/
- 2. Press the **more options** button (three dots icon).
- 3. Press Install app.
- 4. The app will be added to your **phone home screen**.

Moodle stand

Live captioning and translating

We will be piloting an auto-captioning and translation system (Microsoft Present Live) during presentations at MoodleMoot Global 2023. To make use of the system, you will be able to scan a QR code or visit a URL which will be provided before presentations. This will allow you to see the presentation slides on your device in real time, and read live subtitles in your preferred language.

Before a presentation begins:

Point your device camera at the QR code and tap the link that appears, or navigate to the provided URL in a web browser.




Once a presentation is underway:

In a web browser, navigate to the URL displayed above the presentation.



PowerPoint will load the presentation in your web browser. There's nothing for you to install.





Live captioning and translating

Features of Microsoft Present Live include:

Live captioning

See spoken words transcribed on the screen in near realtime.

View slides

Follow the presentation slides live on your device, and use "pinch to zoom" to see slides more clearly.

Automatic translation

Tap the language indicator and select from any of the supported languages. Spoken words will be machine translated into that language.

Review previous slides

Use the controls to navigate back through previous slides. You can go all the way back to the first slide, but only as far forward as the slide currently displayed.

Live feedback

Tap the feedback button (a smiley face) on your device and select from a handful of different feedback types, from "like", "puzzled" and more. The selection will briefly appear on the presentation screen.





Best presentation competition

We will be looking to you to help us find the best presentation of MoodleMoot Global 2023.

After the event, all attendees can cast their vote for the best presentation when completing the event feedback survey.

The presentation with the most votes will win 1 free ticket to the next MoodleMoot Global conference. In the case of a draw, a panel of judges will decide the winning presentation.

Voting will close midnight Friday 6 October 2023 (GMT+2).

For those staying at the hotel and checking out on the last day of the Moot, you may use the hotel cloakroom to store your luggage before you depart.


Give us your feedback












Venue map
